


2nd Annual "Ella's Run" to Support Hubbard Family Set for May 9th

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Hubbard, NE (ABC9 News) - The community of Hubbard, NE is once again coming together for a local family. The town is holding a 5K on Sunday, May 9th called "Ella's Run." Proceeds will help send 4-year-old Ella Watkins and her family to a national conference in Orlando, Florida.

Ella was born with Cornelia de Lange Syndrome (CdLS), a rare genetic disorder that causes a range of physical, cognitive and medical challenges. At the conference, Ella will be able to receive head-to-toe consultations with experts from a range of medical and educational fields, attend workshops, and have opportunities to meet other families facing similar challenges.

A portion of the proceeds raised by the race will also be donated to the CdLS Foundation to help further research of this rare syndrome.

Registration for Ella's Runs starts Sunday, May 9th at 8:30am, with the race beginning at 9:00am. The course begins 1 mile South of Hubbard on M Avenue.
