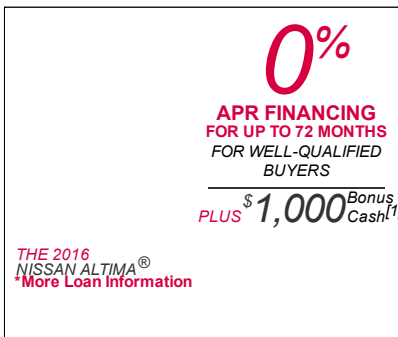
The young daughter of a Charlottesville police officer is recovering from a serious illness, and on Saturday, Shenandoah Joe Coffee Roasters will match all donations to help with her medical expenses.

From 8 a.m. to noon Saturday, Shenandoah Joe, at 945 Preston Ave. in Charlottesville, will match any donations made to help Jolie Ketchum, who has been at the University of Virginia Medical Center since Nov. 20 with a respiratory virus.



The little girl also was recently diagnosed as having Cornelia de Lange syndrome, a genetic disorder that can cause a range of physical and cognitive challenges.

Friends of the family and Charlottesville police hope to raise \$10,000 to help the Ketchums cover the medical expenses.
